Literacy

Make notes while watching a programme, choosing key words, facts, numbers, phrases to record.

- Must have sufficient notes to contribute to class discussion on report.
- Should make sufficient notes that they can be used to write a simple non-chronological report.
- Could have notes sufficient to write a more detailed report

Identify and use key features of Non Chronological Reports with purpose of describing the characteristics of something from the topic "Ancient Greece" as an encyclopaedia entry or section in information book.

- Must produce writing which communicates meaning clearly...using appropriate and interesting vocabulary and showing some awareness of the reader. Sentences sometimes demarcated by full stops and capital letters
- Should produce writing which is organised, imaginative and clear. Main features of the form is used appropriately, beginning to adapt to different readers. Sequences of sentences extend ideas logically and words are chosen for variety and interest. Grammatical structure of sentences correct. Full stops, caps and question marks usually accurate.

Maths

- Know names of 2D shapes and relate to drawings of them
- Know properties of 2D shapes; describe, visualise, classify and draw and make the shapes
- Use a set square to draw right angles and to identify right angles in 2D shapes
- Compare angles with a right angle
- Recognise that a straight line is equivalent to two right angles
- Order acute and obtuse angles (by sight)
- Relate 3D solids to drawings of them

- Know properties of 3D shapes; describe, visualise, classify and draw and make 3D shapes
