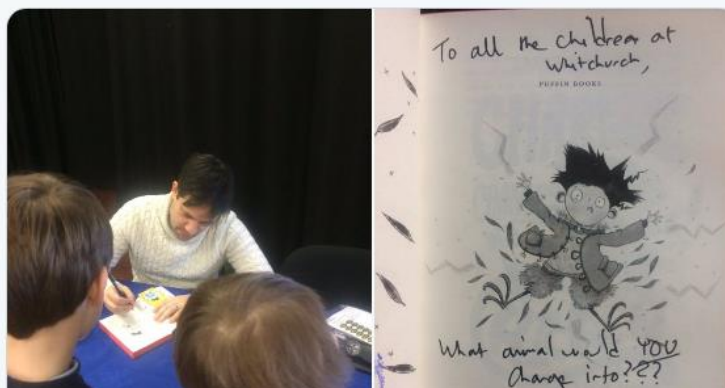


Thank you very much for our book donations and thank you so much to everyone that helped with the book fair last week.
